



Middle School Social Studies Teacher

The candidate must be a certified teacher in Rhode Island or be able to obtain certification within one year in R.I. A minimum of two years teaching experience in the area of social studies is preferred. The ideal candidate will be energetic, creative, and highly motivated and will be able to uphold and promote the teachings of the Catholic Church.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

1. Teach courses in social studies, history, geography, American government, political science, or humanities to students in grades 6, 7 and 8, utilizing core curriculum.
2. Develops a balanced social studies program involving factual background material, material on current events, discussion time, and other appropriate activities.
3. Provides individual and small group instruction in order to adapt the curriculum to the needs of pupils with varying intellectual abilities, attitudes, and cultural backgrounds.
4. Establishes and maintains standards of pupil behavior needed to provide an orderly, and productive environment during class sessions.
5. Selects and requests books, and instructional aids, and maintains inventory records as required; may request resource speakers and field trips.
6. Identifies pupil needs, and cooperates with other professional staff members in assessing and helping pupils solve health, attitude, and learning problems.
7. Effectively communicates with parents on pupil progress.
