



Spanish Teacher

JOB SUMMARY: Our Lady of Mercy School is seeking a full-time teacher of Spanish for Kindergarten to 8th grade. The candidate must be a certified teacher in Rhode Island or be able to obtain certification within one year in R.I. A minimum of two years teaching experience in Spanish is preferred. The ideal candidate will be energetic, creative, and highly motivated and will be able to uphold and promote the teachings of the Catholic Church.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

1. Teach basic Spanish language skills from grades K to 5th grades and a High School preparatory curriculum to 6th to 8th grade students.
2. Emphasis is to engage students through both cultural and academic experiences.
3. Provides individual and small group instruction in order to adapt the curriculum to the needs of pupils with varying intellectual abilities, and attitudes.
4. Selects and requests books, and instructional aids, and maintains inventory records as required; may request resource speakers and field trips.
5. Communicates and collaborates with parents and the school community through effective and ongoing communication.
6. Fosters and manages a safe, positive learning environment through creating an environment of respect and rapport, managing classroom procedures, student behavior and organizing a safe physical space for student learning.
7. Attend or participate in all required staff meetings and other activities deemed necessary by the Pastor and/or building Principal, in order to accomplish the objectives of the position and for professional development.
