G.K. Chesterton famously wrote in *What's Wrong with the World*, "The Christian ideal has not been tried and found wanting. It has been found difficult; and left untried." What we consider Christianity today boils down to simply being a good and nice person. To understand Jesus in this way is to say, like Peter: "I do not know the man." There is so much more to the faith and to the Gospel message. Those who listened to Christ understood this: "This saying is hard; who can accept it?"
