This past season the OLM Cross Country team had a fun and exciting season! Being a member of the OLM Cross Country team is a great way to start off the school year and have fun with your friends, show pride in OLM and compete against other Catholic schools throughout the state. Our team is comprised of runners of all ability who support and encourage each other during our 6 week season.

To give a brief overview for new runners, we begin practicing in August at our home practice field in Goddard Park. As school begins, our practices usually run on Mondays and Fridays at 3:00 in Goddard Park. Meets are on Wednesdays and all but two of them are at Goddard Park. The other two, one of them being the end of season state meet, are at Slater Park in Pawtucket. We begin in August with light workouts and gradually work our way up to meet distance and speed.

In order to ensure that uniforms will be ready for the start of the season and team registration with the league, there will be a cutoff date for sign-ups in mid-August.
